

ULTIMATE TEXAS HOLD 'EM

BEAT THE DEALER!

Players make equal “ante” and “blind” bets. A “trips” bonus bet may also be made. Two “hole” cards are dealt to each player, and they can either check or bet 3x or 4x their ante. The dealer then reveals the first three “flop” cards, and players who haven’t made a “play” bet may pass or bet twice their ante. The dealer reveals the final two community cards, and players may fold or bet equal to their ante bet. Then, the dealer’s two hole cards are revealed. If players’ hands beat the dealer’s, their ante and play bets win even money. If the dealer beats a player, the player loses. The blind bet pays if the winning hand is at least a straight.

Ante/Blind: Wagers added made before the deal

Hole Cards: Players’ down cards

Play: To call or stay in

Trips: Three-of-a-kind

Blind Pay Table

Royal Flush	500 to 1

Flush	3 to 2
Straight	1 to 1
