## TAKE A SPIN!

Roulette is easy to play and exciting. Roulette is defined by both its wheel and layout. A roulette wheel has 38 partitions, and each partition has a number between 1 and 36, including 0 and 00. There are 18 red numbers and 18 black numbers, and 0 and 00 are green. The same numbers and colors appear in sequence on the layout, along with betting spaces for red and black, odd and even, and specific number combinations.

Players place chips on the layout spaces to bet on one or more numbers, colors, or combinations. The dealer spins the roulette wheel in one direction and spins a ball in the opposite direction. The ball drops into a partition to indicate the winning number, color, or combination.

Payoffs are based on how many combinations are wagered.

Five Numbers (1st Five)	6 to 1

Twelve Numbers (Dozen)	2 to 1
Twelve Numbers (Column)	2 to 1

1-18 or 19-36 Even Money
Odd or Even Even Money
Red or Black Even Money
